

Penguin Washcloth

Size: approximately 8" X 8 ¼ ".

Materials: One skein of worsted weight cotton in a solid color. Approximately 98 yards. The cloth pictured was done in Peaches & Crème in Rose Pink.

Needles: U.S. Size 6/4.0mm or 5/3.75mm Because this is a “picture” cloth, you want your fabric to be fairly dense so the design will pop out. If you are a loose knitter, then you might want to drop down a needle size.

Gauge: 4.5 sts. per inch, not critical.

Abbreviations:

k = knit

p = purl

sts. = stitches

Pattern:

Cast on 37 stitches

Rows 1 – 8: p1, k1, across row.

Row 9: (right side) (k1, p1) x5; k17; (p1, k1) x5.

Row 10: (k1, p1) x4; k1; p19; k1; (p1, k1) x4.

Row 11: (k1, p1) x4; k21; (p1, k1) x4.

Row 12: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p23; k1; (p1, k1) x3.

Row 13: (k1, p1) x3; k25; (p1, k1) x3.

Row 14: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p7; k6; p1; k6; p7; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 15: (k1, p1) x2; k9; p11; k9; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 16: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p9; k9; p9; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 17: (k1, p1) x2; k11; p7; k11; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 18: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p11; k5; p11; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 19: (k1, p1) x2; k11; p7; k11; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 20: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p9; k3; p3; k3; p9; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 21: (k1, p1) x2; k9; p3; k5; p3; k9; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 22: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p8; k2; p7; k2; p8; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 23: (k1, p1) x2; k9; p2; k7; p2; k9; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 24: (k1, p1) x2; k1; (p3, k2) x2; p7; (k2, p3) x2; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 25: (k1, p1) x2; k4; p3; k2; p2; k7; p2; k2; p3; k4; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 26: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p3; k4; p1; k2; p7; k2; p1; k4; p3; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 27: (k1, p1) x2; k4; p4; k1; p2; k7; p2; k1; p4; k4; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 28: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p4; k6; p7; k6; p4; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 29: (k1, p1) x2; k6; p6; k5; p6; k6; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 30: (k1, p1) x2; k1; (p5, k6) x2; p5; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 31: (k1, p1) x2; k7; p5; k5; p5; k7; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 32: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p7; k5; p3; k5; p7; k1; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 33: (k1, p1) x2; k9; p4; k3; p4; k9; (p1, k1) x2.

Row 34: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p9; k9; p9; k1; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 35: (k1, p1) x2; k11; p7; k11; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 36: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p10; k7; p10; k1; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 37: (k1, p1) x2; k10; p4; k1; p4; k10; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 38: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p9; k3; p3; k3; p9; k1; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 39: (k1, p1) x2; k10; p3; k3; p3; k10; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 40: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p9; k3; p3; k3; p9; k1; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 41: (k1, p1) x2; k10; p9; k10; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 42: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p9; k9; p9; k1; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 43: (k1, p1) x2; k10; p2; k1; p3; k1; p2; k10; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 44: (k1, p1) x2; k1; p10; k7; p10; k1; (p1, k1) x2.
Row 45: (k1, p1) x3; k10; p5; k10; (p1, k1) x3.
Row 46: (k1, p1) x3; k1; p23; k1; (p1, k1) x3.
Row 47: (k1, p1) x4; k21; (p1, k1) x4.
Row 48: (k1, p1) x4; k1; p19; k1; (p1, k1) x4.
Row 49: (k1, p1) x5; k17; (p1, k1) x5.
Rows 50 – 57: (k1, p1) across row.
Bind off in k1, p1 and weave in ends.
